These items are not permitted in the bins:

- propane tanks
- ammunition
- leftover paint, paint cans and paint thinner, stains and varnish
- household cleaning products
- batteries
- fluorescent light bulbs
- tires, motor oil, gasoline and antifreeze
- aerosol cans
- pesticides and fertilizers
- · pharmaceuticals and bio-medical waste
- Dirt

Central Air Conditioning Option

Reliance is offering members an opporutnity to have central air rental units installed. The cost of rentals is \$43.99 plus tax a month. These would be added on to your monthly charges *only* if you opt into the program.



Benefits of the Central Air Option

- Even cooling of the entire unit compared to using a window a/c
- Lower hydro rates compared to window a/c use
- Rental charges cover maintenance and service of the units
- Doesn't damage the window frames
- Minimal disruption during installation

Reliance does not require 100% of the units to opt in to the rental, however there needs to be enough interest to make it worth while.

Anyone that would like this option is asked to let the office by Wednesday May 30th.

We've had members asking about sod for their yards. If there are enough members wanting sod, the co-op will look into the costs of a bulk purchase. Anyone interested in purchasing sod at a reduced cost are asked to let the office know by **Wednesday May 23**rd.
