#### **Unit Safety**

Sleeping quarters in the basement are not permitted as there needs to be an alternate exit in case of fire, should the stairs be blocked. The basement windows do not meet the requirements of an exit.

### **Community News**

All co-ops strive for an environment that is fair, inclusive and respectful of people's dignity. Sometimes people's actions, certain images and comments can adversely affect someone without even realizing it. Keep in mind that some things are culturally insensitive and may reasonably interfere with other members in the community, making them feel uncomfortable and unsafe.

## **Garbage Clean Up and Curb Appeal**

We cannot stress enough the importance of keeping the exterior of your unit clear of garbage and debris, not just for curb appeal, but to help deter the rodents, pest and wildlife.

Recycle bins, green bins and garbage containers should not be left in front your units. These are to be kept in your enclosed backyard or garage.

Toys, bikes, chairs and tables should be put away when you are finished with them and not left on the front lawns.

Driveways are meant for your properly plated and insured vehicle and should not be used as storage. If you require bulk pick-up of unwanted items, you must call the city at 905-546-2489 and make arrangements prior to putting things out.

Grocery Carts – If you bring a grocery cart on to the property, you are responsible for returning it to the store. Carts are not to be left on co-op property.

Glass – There has been quite a bit of broken glass around the co-op lately. This can be damaging to tires and dangerous for the kids and pets walking around the co-op. Zibi does do walkarounds, but members are being asked to clean it up if you see it. Members are also encouraged to pick up any trash laying around, or items that may have fallen out of your recycle bins on collection day.

#### Children playing the roadways
