

## Memo for Members ~ November 12, 2018

**Salt Bins** ~ As some of you may have heard recently in the news, there is a road salt shortage for the coming winter season. Contractors, such as ours, have a **VERY LIMITED** supply. Members are not to take salt from the bins in the common areas for use at their units. The contractor will not be able to refill the bins like they have in previous years. The bins are there for the contractors to properly salt our common areas. Members are strongly encouraged to purchase a couple bags of salt when they see it in the stores to keep at their unit.

**Safety Concerns** ~ On Thursday, November 9, 2018 around 9:15 p.m., an adult female was riding her bicycle east on Limeridge Rd E near Leggett Crescent when a male suspect stopped her and engaged her in conversation. During the conversation, the suspect grabbed her cell phone. The male then persuaded the female to follow him towards a grassy area on Leggett Crescent and sexually assaulted her. The male was last seen leaving west on Limeridge Road East heading towards Upper Sherman Avenue.

The suspect is described as follows:

Male, black, 6'0, thin to medium build, wearing a dark hoodie, no coat, black hair that was curly in the front that came down to his eyebrows. His hair was covered with his hoodie, but when removed the hair fell forward to his eyebrows.
