Members are reporting damage to their vehicles and property

After the hard work that went into making the co-op gardens look good, some of the co-op children removed the lights, broke them, and damaged the flowers.

Garbage around the co-op (wrappers, bottles, papers, food waste, toys etc.) continues. It is not the responsibility of other members to pick up after your children. To those members that do, thank you for trying to keep our co-op clean.

The younger children are playing in the laneways and not watching the vehicles. There have been a few close calls.

The older children should play ball either off site at the local park or in the grassy area behind the units, and not in the laneways.

The co-op is private property and you may feel a sense of safety and security with your children, particularly the young ones, left out to wander the entire complex on their own, but remember any one can come on site.

Parents need to be aware and be accountable. Our co-op's bylaws state that you are responsible for the actions or failure to act of your children, and their guests.

Children should be reminded of the rules for their safety.

If you send your child out with a snack make sure they return any garbage to you.
