A list of items not permitted in the bins is on the back.

## These items are **not** permitted in the bins:



- propane tanks
- ammunition
- leftover paint, paint cans and paint thinner, stains and varnish
- household cleaning products
- batteries
- fluorescent light bulbs
- tires, motor oil, gasoline and antifreeze
- aerosol cans
- Dirt, pesticides and fertilizers
- pharmaceuticals and bio-medical waste
