

Spring Clean Up Bins are coming Monday May 13th

Bins will be located in the following places:

1 – in the parking area between units #37 and #38

1 – in the parking area beside unit #50 ** scrap metal drop off beside this bin

1 – in the parking area at 100 Leggett Crescent

Members are asked to make sure the parking spaces in these areas are cleared by **6 am on Monday May 13th** in order for the bins to be dropped off.

They will be swapping out the bins on Wednesday and Friday, should they be full.

Bins will be removed on Tuesday May 21st.

DO NOT place items higher than the sides of the bin. Bins that are overflowing will not be removed. If the bin is full **DO NOT** leave your items beside the bin. They will not remove it.

The bins on Limeridge are for **ALL** members of Limeridge, regardless of where their unit is. Just because a bin is at one end does not mean that others cannot use it.

Please do not clear out a large amount big items (dressers, beds, couches etc.) from your unit. The bins are for everyone. The City of Hamilton picks up furniture and other bulk items every week that are too big to fit into a garbage bag or can. Call 905-546-2489 at least one week before you want your bulk garbage picked up

The bins are for bulk items only. Your regular weekly household garbage must still be put out to the curb for pick up and not placed in the bins.

Scrap metal items are to be placed neatly beside the bin located in the parking lot by unit #50

These items are not permitted in the bins:

- propane tanks
- ammunition
- leftover paint, paint cans and paint thinner, stains and varnish
- household cleaning products
- batteries
- fluorescent light bulbs
- tires, motor oil, gasoline and antifreeze
- aerosol cans
- pesticides and fertilizers
- pharmaceuticals and bio-medical waste
- Dirt
